The Clinical Emergency Management Program (CEMP) Advanced workshops have been designed to further build participants' knowledge, skills and confidence when responding to medical emergencies. These workshops are facilitated by a national team of highly trained intensive care paramedics. This workshop has been designed by GPs for GPs in direct response to feedback requesting an additional intensive workshop focusing on advanced adult resuscitation and paediatric emergencies.

### Eligibility criteria

To be eligible to register for a CEMP Advanced workshop, participants must have successfully completed within the last 3 years either a CEMP Intermediate workshop or an equivalent course that meets CPR practice competencies. For acknowledgement of recognition of the equivalent course, participants are required to submit program objectives and/or a copy of the assessed competencies and a copy of the certificate of attendance when faxing their registration form. Special consideration for exemption from prerequisites may be granted in some cases where a participant has extensive emergency management experience. Requests for consideration outlining the participant's experience must be submitted with the registration form.

### Designed for

Designed for, general practice registrars and registered medical practitioners including, international medical graduates (IMGs) with high level responsibility in emergency trauma care.

### Content

- Advanced airway management: airway management review, managing the difficult airway
- The trauma patient: trauma systems, time critical guidelines, systematic approach
- Patient assessment and monitoring: primary and secondary survey, manual defibrillation
- Common paediatric emergencies
- The paediatric patient: basic life support, airway management and paediatric cardiac arrests
- Online predisposing activity pre-workshop and online reinforcing activity post-workshop

- Demonstrate an effective systematic approach to the assessment of the adult trauma patient

Participants who meet the required standard will be provided with a Certificate of Completion at the conclusion of the workshop. In order to be eligible to participate in this workshop, IMGs will need to have applied for, or completed assessment of their overseas GP experience by RACGP sensors and one of the following:

- Have passed the AMC examination (written and clinical) or equivalent
- Be enrolled in the RACGP specialist pathway
- Be undertaking general practice/or general practice training

## Training grants

The Rural Procedural Grants Program provides financial support to maintain and enhance the clinical skills of GPs and locums who deliver:

- unsupervised anaesthetics, obstetrics and / or surgery in ACGC-RA 1\*-5 locations (1\* dependent on additional approval)
- unsupervised emergency medicine in 24-hour triaging Accident and Emergency facilities located in ASGC-RA 2-5 locations.

This financial support is offered as a grant of \$2000 per day for up to 10 days of training per financial year for procedural GPs and for up to 3 days of training per financial year for GPs providing hospital based emergency services.

GPs who attend a CEMP workshop may be eligible for a training grant but they must be registered in the grants program prior to attending the workshop.
